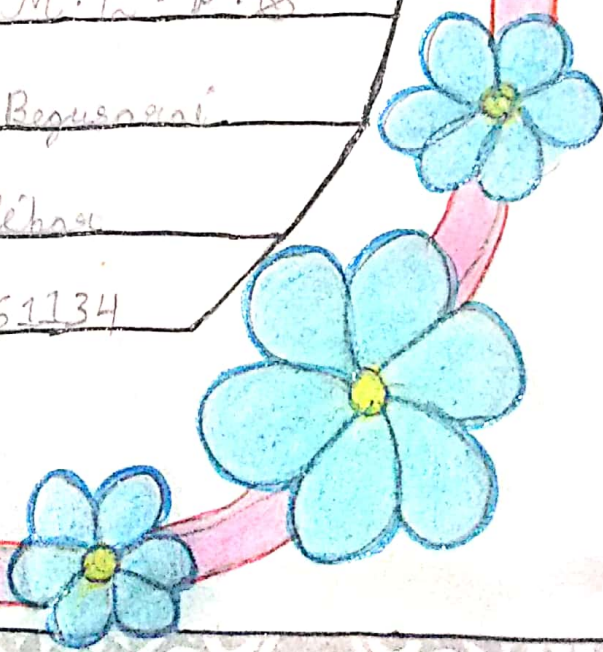

Dr. B.R. Ambedkar

Dr B.R Ambedkar is considered one of the great personalities and heroes of our country and he was known as a leading politician and an economist. He was born on 14 April 1891 in M.P. He was the fourth child of his parents, and raised by his aunt.

He loved to read Sanskrit but he was not allowed to read the books of Sanskrit being from a lower caste. Due to society made him stand and fight against it. He changed the mindset of upper-class people in such a way that there was no difference between the lower-class and upper-class people.

He was very humiliated during his elementary education. Teachers don't touch his books, other children don't talk to him, and he was not allowed

to drink water where other children's drink.

After the death of his father he completed his studies, he was a very talented student. Hence Maharaja of Karsada gave him a monthly scholar of 25 rupees and also gave him the facility to study abroad. He completed his matriculation in 1907 and his BA in 1912. Ambedkar went to England and studied economics, politics and law here from 1913 to 1917.

Maharaja of Karsada gave him 10 years of scholarship which helped him in completing his studies but his life was not better after the studies he was not respected much in his office and was not allowed to drink water in the office and he resigned after being humiliated in the office. He won a murder case and then everyone has to admire his intelligence.

He wrote many books like "The untouchable who are they?", "Who were the shudras?", "Buddhism of his Dhamma", "Parliament and partition of India",

After India's independence on 15 August 1947, he became the first law minister of India. He was appointed as the chairman of the constitution Drafting Committee. He is recognised as father of Indian constitution. B.R. Ambedkar was undoubtedly the most suitable person for this job. He had vast knowledge about the constitution. He studied constitution of 60 countries.
